- a. Southgate Water Systems, Inc. has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation commission to increase rates \$10,554 (27 percent) annually. If approved, the rates will be effective on March 1, 2009.
- b. The current rate and proposed rates are shown below:

- c. The water meters will be read 12-31, 3-31, 4-30, 5-31, 6-30, 7-31, 8-31, and 9-30 to calculate water usage.
- d. The increase in rates is necessary to cover operating costs, to provide water and maintain the water system, and recover a portion of the capital improvements. The rates are designed to encourage water conservation while applying a base rate for the water availability. Some of the major costs that Southgate Water Systems, Inc. incurs each year are set forth below:

Maintenance of water system
Pump repair and maintain utilities
Engineering
Water testing and chemicals
Health Department fees and licenses
Reading meters
Billing services
Legal & accounting
Property and business taxes
Office supplies and postage
Insurance
Electricity (which has increased substantially)

- 2. During 2007, repair expense of \$20,722 was incurred as a result of an electrical surge.
- 3. The water rates in effect for the past four years have not covered direct costs and did not provide any return on the capital of approximately \$730,000 invested in the water system or provide any funds for future capital replacement costs.
