## Dear Mr. Danner:

Enclosed you will find the original and three copies of the above-referenced tariff sheets. The purpose of this filing is to continue the restructuring of rates that began with the reduction of the treatment surcharge that became effective July 17, 2009. This filing also initiates a general rate increase. The Company's costs of operation exceed its revenues and is the reason for this filing.

The proposal would increase all rates by 3.4% over 2008 revenues. The table below sets out the effect on the average customer.
