NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE

Date: December 23, 2009

The City of Everett has again increased its water rates for 2010 that will affect an increase for the Northwest Water System. The Northwest Water System has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) for an increase in basic service rates. The filing is expected to generate approximately \$4,000.00 in additional revenue on an annual basis. If approved, the rates will become effective on February 1, 2010.

The filing is a straight pass-through of the increase in the water utility rates adopted by the City of Everett. The City increase means that the base rate will increase by approximately 2% for the base rate; approximately 43% for the first usage block and approximately 26.5% for the second usage block. The table below sets out the current and proposed rates:

This tariff filing does no more than pass through the City's rate increase. There is no additional profit or cost recovery for the Company.

The commission has the authority to set final rates that may vary from the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on January 28, 2010.
