Avista Corporation ("the Company") hereby submits the attached filing seeking Commission authorization to increase its rates and charges for its electric and natural gas services to its electric and natural gas customers in the state of Washington. With this filing the Company requests an overall increase in billed rates of 8.7% (9.1% in base rates) or \$38.3 million for electric service and 4.0% in billed rates (4.0% in base rates) or \$6.2 million for natural gas service, to be implemented at the end of the general rate case proceedings.

Additionally, Avista Corporation requests that the Commission **immediately suspend the operation of the general tariff revisions** included in this filing, and set the matter for hearing, including the establishment of a prehearing conference, at the earliest possible date in accordance with WAC 480-07-440(1)(a).

In support of this filing, the Company has enclosed 19 copies of its prepared direct testimony and exhibits, as well as 3 copies of workpapers showing how test year data were adjusted. Additionally as required by WAC 480-07-160(3)(a), the Company is also submitting an Attorney's Claim of Confidentiality regarding the submission of the unredacted versions of the above-referenced CONFIDENTIAL exhibits and workpapers. These workpapers should be treated as CONFIDENTIAL per WAC 480-07-160 and RCW 80-04-095.

In addition, as part of this filing, the Company is specifically requesting **deferred accounting treatment** of changes in generating plant operation and maintenance costs related to its Coyote Springs 2 natural gas-fired plant and its 15% ownership share of the Colstrip 3 & 4 coal-fired generating plants. Company witness Ms. Andrews discusses the request and associated justification in Exhibit No.___(EMA-1T).

Three copies of a "Notice of Tariff Change" are enclosed. This notice will be posted in the Company's offices coincident with the date of this filing. A service list is attached, with the parties on the service list receiving a complete copy of the pre-filed testimony and exhibits.

In compliance with WAC 480-07-510(3)(i) the Company states that there are no additional material affiliated transactions to report that otherwise were not already reported in the Company's annual Report of Affiliated Interest Transactions for the test year. The Company's annual report was filed on April 29, 2011. (See Dockets UE-110771 and UG-110772)
