NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL CERTIFICATION AS A NONPROFIT BUS AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING

Re: Cancellation of Nonprofit Bus Certificate for Failure to File Annual Safety Report and Pay Regulatory Fee; Docket TN-111553

TO PACIFIC AGING COUNCIL ENDEAVORS:

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) recently conducted its yearly review of annual safety reports and regulatory fees for non-profit buses certified in the state of Washington. As a result, Commission staff identified Pacific Aging Council Endeavors as not complying with regulatory requirements.

Your company failed to file its annual safety report for 2010 and/or failed to pay its regulatory fee for 2011. This notice is being served to your last known addresses on file with the Commission.

WAC 480-30-071(2)(d) and WAC 480-30-076(5) provide that the Commission may cancel a carrier's certificate for failure to file its required annual safety report or pay its regulatory fees, respectively.

If you wish to avoid cancellation of your certificate, you must, within 30 days of service of this notice, take one of two actions. The first option is to come into compliance with the Commission's statutes and rules by submitting the delinquent annual safety report and paying the delinquent regulatory fees. Annual safety report forms are available on the Commission's Web site: http://www.utc.wa.gov. You also may obtain annual safety report forms by contacting the Commission by e-mail at annualreports@utc.wa.gov or telephone at (360) 664-1160.

The second option is to request a hearing to demonstrate why your certificate should not be canceled. All requests for hearing must comply with the Commission's procedural rules, contained in WAC 480-07, which are available at the Commission's Web site: http://www.utc.wa.gov.

If you do not respond to this notice within 30 days of the service date of this notice by complying with the regulatory requirements or requesting a hearing, the Commission will enter an order cancelling your certificate without further notice. Unregistered companies are prohibited from providing charter and excursion services in the state of Washington.
