RE: Rabanco Ltd dba SeaTac Disposal Tariff filing

Dear Mr. Danner,

Enclosed please find proposed Tariff No. 26 of Rabanco Ltd G-12, (dba SeaTac Disposal Company), the purpose of which is as follows:

1) Propose new rates to include the impact of the increase in King County's disposal rate per ton from \$109.00 to \$120.17 effective January 1, 2013.

If approved by the Commission, the overall revenue requirement increase reflected in this filing would approximate 2.6% or \$72,770 for Commercial and Residential customers. The disposal increase for roll-off customers only impacts pass through disposal revenue, there is no change to haul rates for these customers.

Notification of a rate increase related to the King County disposal fee increase will be included in the first invoice mailed subsequent to WUTC approval of the proposed rates.

Due to the interval between the general last rate filing and this submission, the Company now commits to filing a general rate case on or before January 16, 2013.

Should the Commission act subsequently for whatever reason to suspend these proposed increased disposal fee rates, we request, pursuant to RCW 81.77.160 (2), that temporary rates subject to refund be granted as provided by law.

Finally, we would now also request that the Commission, on its own Motion under WAC 480-07-370 (b), treat this disposal fee only filing as an exception to the general rate case workpaper rule at WAC 480-07-520.
