Dear Valued Customer,

Waste Management is pleased to be your recycling and solid waste services provider. We are writing to notify you of an upcoming rate adjustment.

Like all of us, the garbage and recycling industry is faced with many challenges today. Since the last rate adjustment, in January of 2009; nearly four years ago; the costs of fuel, equipment, labor, operating expenses and disposal have increased. We have made substantial investments in facility upgrades to fuel our new compressed natural gas (CNG) trucks. We have purchased many of these new CNG fueled trucks that will be more efficient, will reduce emissions and will help protect the environment. We have converted your recycling collection containers from a small 18-gallon bin with a new 96-gallon recycling cart. With this new cart you will be able to recycle all your mixed waste paper and cardboard that previously was not allowed. In addition, we have made a substantial investment in our newly constructed SmART Recycling Center ("SmART") that allows us to process these mixed recyclables to attain their highest potential value.

The proposed recycling rates reflect the above mentioned investments and associated costs. To mitigate this increase we are also proposing that the commodity rebate that you current receive be increased as well to more accurately reflect the true value of your recyclables.

Accordingly, we have applied for an increase in your garbage, recycling and yard waste rates and an increase in your commodity rebate, subject to the review and approval of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). The UTC, upon completing its investigation, has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher from the proposed rates shown on the back of this letter. If approved, the new rates would become effective March 5, 2013.

The UTC is scheduled to make a decision at its open meeting on February 28, 2013.
