IMPORTANT NOTICE

Mashell Telecom, Inc. is filing with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") to increase its business measured service rate effective May 1, 2013, to \$18.75 a month. The existing rate is \$10.75. This is a change of \$8.00 per month. Measured service includes up to 30 local calls per month. Additional local calls are each \$0.15.

Due to a recent Federal Communications Commission Order (FCC Order No. 11-161), the Company is required to increase its residential measured service plan rates or face a corresponding reduction in Universal Service support. Business rates were not directly affected by this FCC Order. Since business service typically costs more to provide, the Company is also increasing rates for measured business services by an amount equivalent to the residential rate increase.

Rainier Connect offers flat rate business lines for \$24.00 per month with no per-call charges beyond the first 30. Businesses that currently have measured service may wish to consider switching to our flat rate plan now that there is less difference between our flat rate plan and the base rate for measured service lines.

The Commission has the authority to set rates that may vary from the Company's request, depending on the outcome of its investigation. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on April 25, 2013. You will have an opportunity to comment in person at this meeting. If you are unable to attend the open meeting, the Commission has a bridge line which enables you to participate by telephone.
