Present provisions are: For any WTAP application made from August 12, 2010 through August 12, 2013, the Company will provide a one time \$75 credit to any WTAP-qualified customer that fails to receive the appropriate discount, credit, or waiver of the deposit within the first bill cycle after application, provided that for existing customers the application is received ten or more calendar days prior to the end of the customer's bill cycle.

Proposed changes are: Remove the expired Washington Telephone Assistance Program (WTAP) one time \$75.00 credit that was effective August 12, 2010 through August 12, 2013, originally filed in advice letter 3300, August 4, 2010, in compliance with Order No. 6 in Docket UT-090842.

Indicate below, or attach, an explanation of the reason the company requests permission to file the proposed provisions with less than statutory notice and to provide notification to customers on less than required notice.

It is important to eliminate the WTAP one time credit that expires August 12, 2013.
