Lauren McCloy, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declares as follows:

1. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a Compliance Investigator in the Consumer Protection and Communications Section. As a Compliance Investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations regarding the business practices of regulated utility or transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate household goods carriers that may be operating without the required Commission permit.
2. I began an investigation into the activities of Daniel Eddy and Janyce Stone d/b/a Danny the Mover in May 2013 because I received an email from a permitted carrier containing a link to a website, www.dannythemover.com, indicating that the company is conducting household goods moves within the state of Washington without a permit. The site advertises "winter rates" of \$80 per hour for "two movers, a truck, gas, insurance and all necessary moving equipment."¹
3. I conducted an Internet search for "Danny the Mover," and found advertisements on www.facebook.com and www.angieslist.com.²
4. A search of Washington Department of Revenue's (DOR) Business Licensing Service produced a record for Janyce A. Stone d/b/a Danny the Mover and JD's Quality Moving Services. The entity's UBI number is


602699102, and its business address is registered as 4807-200th St. SW #J-103, Lynnwood, WA, 98036.

5. I reviewed Commission records related to Daniel Eddy and Janyce Stone d/b/a Danny the Mover to determine whether the company held a household goods permit. According to Commission records, as of August 22, 2013, there is no record of Daniel Eddy and Janyce Stone d/b/a Danny the Mover now (or ever) holding a household goods permit. Records indicate, however, that Dan Eddy and Janyce Stone previously applied for a household goods carrier permit as Vice President and Secretary, respectively, of Tom's Action Moving Co. Inc. in 2009, owned by Thomas Shanks. This company, which changed its name to Active Moving Co. Inc., was ordered to cease and desist operations as a household goods carrier in Docket # TV-091641 on November 24, 2009.
6. On May 24, 2013, I sent an email to dannythemover@aol.com requesting an estimate for a move from a two-bedroom house in Everett to a two-bedroom house in Lynnwood. I received a response from "Janyce," telling me that the company charges "\$80.00 per hour for 2 movers and a fully equipped 24' truck."³
7. On May 31, the Commission sent a letter to Daniel Eddy and Janyce Stone d/b/a Danny the Mover aka JD's Quality Moving Services, (1) outlining the licensing process for household goods movers, directing them to (2) become licensed within a reasonable time, (3) cease unpermitted operations, and (4) outlining the consequences of operating as an unpermitted household goods mover in Washington state. Mr. Eddy and Ms. Stone were required to respond or apply by June 14, 2013.
8. On June 16, 2013, I confirmed that the letter was not returned, and that the company had not filed an application for a household goods permit. I called 425-791-5377, and spoke to "Janyce." I requested an estimate for moving from a two-bedroom townhouse in Renton to a house in Bellevue. She told me that the company charges \$80 per hour for "two guys and a truck." She said that they have a two-hour minimum, and would charge for 30 minutes of travel time each way. She estimated that my move would take "four to six hours," and "probably cost around \$500."
9. On July 8, 2013, I confirmed that the company had still not filed an application for a household goods permit. I called 425-791-5377 and left a message for Daniel Eddy and Janyce Stone, inquiring whether they received the letter, and requesting that they call me back.

10. On July 10, 2013, I received a phone call from Daniel Eddy. He confirmed that he received the letter dated May 31, 2013. He said that he wants to apply for a permit, but that he does not own a truck, and is currently operating his company and renting trucks for customers. I explained that he can't rent trucks for customers, and he can't advertise rates that include a truck. He said that he intends to apply for a permit, but that he can't do so at this time. He said he intended to apply for a permit as soon as he purchased a truck. I told him that if he doesn't apply for a permit, he is required to cease advertising as a household goods carrier until he obtains a permit. He refused to take down his website, and requested more time to apply for a permit. I emailed him the household goods permit application and directed his call to the Commission's Licensing department.
11. As of August 23, 2013, the company continues to advertise household goods moving services without a permit, and the Commission has not received a permit application from Daniel Eddy or Janyce Stone d/b/a Danny the Mover aka JD's Quality Moving Services.

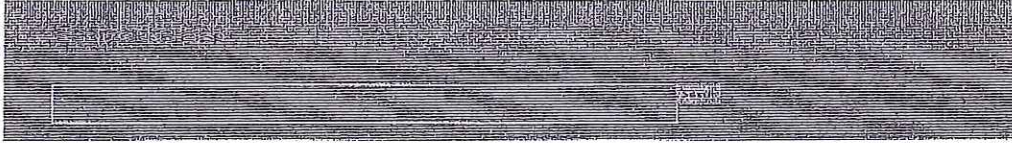

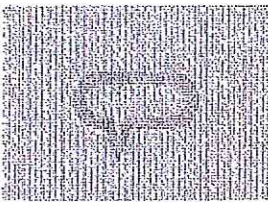
