SCHEDULE 137
TEMPORARY CUSTOMER CHARGE OR CREDIT

1. **AVAILABILITY/APPLICABILITY:** This rate credit or charge is available to all eligible Customers of the Company and will be applied to all bills to Customers with Energy usage during a month when this schedule is effective.
2. **PURPOSE:** This schedule may be used to pass through temporary charges or credits to Customers. The reason and purpose for each use of this schedule will be documented within this paragraph and that reason and purpose will be carried forward on revisions of this sheet for a minimum of three years following termination of a charge or credit.
 - a. Purpose No. 1: Starting November 1, 2010, this schedule will be used to pass through to Customers a credit that is from a portion of the proceeds of the sale of Renewable Energy Credits as provided in Docket No. UE-070725. At the time that the amount passed through to Customers is expected to exceed the amount shown in Section 4 below the Company will request that rates in this schedule be set to zero. The Company requested that rates be set to zero no later than April 30, 2011.
 - b. Purpose No. 2: Starting May 14, 2012, this schedule will be used to pass through to Customers Renewable Energy Credit ("REC") revenue collected by the Company in accordance with the tracker mechanism established in the Multiparty Settlement Re: Electric rate Spread, Electric Rate Design and Renewable Energy Credit Tracker that was attached as Appendix C to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's Order 08 in Docket Nos. UE-111048 and UG-111049 (Consolidated) and to pass through to Customers the net proceeds related to the biogas acquired by PSE in accordance with the Commission's Order in Docket No. UE-131276. (N)
3. **ELIGIBILITY:**
 - a. Eligibility No. 1: All Customers receiving bundled retail service are eligible as provided in Docket No. UE0070725.
 - b. Eligibility No. 2: All Customers receiving bundled retail service.
4. **FUNDING:**
 - a. Funding No. 1: Rate credits of up to a total of \$27,683, 364.
 - b. Funding No. 2: Rate credits of \$16,873,507 (based on estimated loads) for pass through between January 1, 2014 and December 31, 2014. (I)

5. **ADJUSTMENT:** In addition to the rate specified in the otherwise applicable rate schedules the following rate credits or charge will apply from the effective date of this tariff sheet until terminated.
6. **MONTHLY RATE:** The charges or credits shown in this schedule apply to the rate schedules identified on the following sheets and at the charge or credit shown for the applicable rate schedule.

7. TERMINATION:

(M)

a. Purpose No. 1:

As provided in paragraph 14 of Appendix A of the October 26, 2010 order in Docket Nos. UE-070725 and UE-101581 (Consolidated), the rate credit or charge under this schedule will terminate when the total amount to be passed through or charged to Customers is projected to complete. Any balance remaining following termination will be included in the revenue requirement of the next following general rate case or as otherwise ordered by the Utilities and Transportation Commission. Once this remaining balance is included in rates or otherwise utilized the rate credit or charge will not be applied on adjusted Customer bills.

b. Purpose No. 2:

Once any remaining balance following termination is included in rates or otherwise utilized, the rate credit or charge under this schedule will not be applied to adjusted or corrected Customer bills.

8. TRUE-UP AND NOTICE OF RATE CHANGES:

a. Purpose No. 2

As provided in paragraphs 16 and 17 of Appendix C of Order 08 in Docket Nos. UE-111048 and UG-111049 (Consolidated), the initial tracker rates will be set in May, 2012. The rates in this schedule will then be reset annually and will become effective each January 1st. Each annual filing will be trued up for the actual deferred REC proceeds received to date, net of deferred taxes, at the end of the then-current rate period and the interest thereon versus the amounts assumed when setting the rates at the beginning of the period. The rates will also be trued up for any variances between the amounts set in rates and the amount actually passed back to Customers over the period due to variances in load. And, as provided in the Commission's Order in Docket No. UE-131276, the tracker rates effective January 1, 2014 will include the net biogas proceeds through October 31, 2013, of \$10.5 million, amortized over one year. The portion of the rates related to the biogas pass through will be trued up for any variance between the amount set in rates and the amount actually passed back to Customers during 2014 due to variances in load.
