Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and WAC 480-80-101 and WAC 480-80-105(1)(c), please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-2 Tariff for natural gas service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE” or the “Company”):

**146<sup>th</sup> Revision of Sheet No. 101-A – Natural Gas Schedule No. 1, Tax Adjustment (Continued)**

The purpose of this filing is to change the municipal tax within the City of Edgewood (the “City”). A copy of the approved City ordinance, Ordinance No. 14-0413 is enclosed. The Edgewood City Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 13-0401 establishing a 2.67 percent utility tax which became effective January 1, 2014. Upon further consideration on January 21, 2014, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 14-0413 which repeals the previous ordinance and eliminates the tax.

Due to the expedited nature of this repeal and to prevent the impact on customers of further billing of the tax and because this filing represents a decrease in rates, PSE is requesting less than statutory notice approval for this filing. Therefore, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission allow this tariff change to become effective on January 31, 2014 with less than statutory notice (“LSN”). The information required by WAC 480-80-122 is contained throughout this letter and on the attached LSN form provided by the Commission. Ken Johnson is authorized to issue tariff changes on behalf of the Company.

The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of January 23, 2014, and an effective date of February 23, 2014. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and regulations, is being completed through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193.
