- 1 On March 14, 2014, Esquivel Trucking LLC filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a common carrier in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Esquivel Trucking LLC’s application is incomplete as it lacks a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) and there was a balance of 225 dollars remaining on the transfer application.
- 2 On April 29, May 13, 2014 and June 19, 2014, the Commission sent Esquivel Trucking LLC notices to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Esquivel Trucking LLC has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- 3 The application filed by Esquivel Trucking LLC in Docket TV-140419 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

**ORDER**

- 4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by Esquivel Trucking LLC, on March 14, 2014 in Docket TV-140419 for common carrier authority is dismissed.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).

If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.
