

## NOTICE TO OUR VALUED CUSTOMERS

Recent rule changes implemented by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) allow transportation companies to offer flexible fares on regulated services based on currently filed and approved fixed rates. The rule changes allow for a maximum increase of 5% annually over current maximum allowed rates and the lowest rate being reduced to \$0.01.

Capital Aeroporter has submitted a request to the WUTC to apply the new rule change to our existing fares to be effective May 1, 2014 as allowed by law.
