Dear Water Customer:

The Spokane Industrial Park Water Company has filed for a rate increase approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. Company-wide, this represents approximately \$14,303, or an 8 percent increase annually. If approved, the rates will become effective July 16, 2014 and will be reflected in your September 1, 2014 billing statement.

Prior to the 2012 and 2013 rate increases, the Spokane Industrial Park Water Company had not increased water rates since 1999. The combination of the three rate increases represents an equivalent annual inflation of 1.97%. This rate of increase is lower than the actual rate of inflation over this period and would still be insufficient to fully offset the rate of increase in operating expenses, which include wages, insurance, gas and electric utilities, repairs and maintenance expenses. The increase is necessary to maintain the current level of service.
