Dear Mr. King:

Enclosed please find proposed Tariff No.4 of Rabanco Ltd, Certificate G-12, (dba Lynnwood Disposal), the purpose of which is a general rate increase request. The rate case recently submitted and effective as of 7/1/2014 overrepresented the number of recycle only customers and the intention of this filing is to correct that. The rate for recycling service was \$7.67 prior to the 7/1/14 rate case and was dropped by 14%. With the proposed rate recalculation the rate is expected to be \$6.90 which is still a rate reduction of 10% from rates at the beginning of the year .If approved by the Commission, the overall revenue requirement reflected in this filing would not change from the previous case, we would simply be adjusting recycling rates to achieve the intended revenue requirement. % and \$ changes below reflect variances from current rather than LG calculated changes.

The proposed rates impact services provided as follows:
