Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to ORS 759.410, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC is filing notice of revisions to the sheets listed on Attachment A.

On September 16, 2014, CenturyLink made an FCC filing to increase the Federal Access Charge rate for Washington effective October 1, 2014. As a result, this filing is being issued to coincide with the change to the Federal Access rate for primary residential service by revising the Federal Lifeline (ASGFX from \$5.80 to \$5.81 and ASGFR from \$3.45 to \$3.44) while keeping the overall credit at \$9.25. There is no customer impact to these rate changes.

The Washington Telephone Assistance Program (WTAP) State credit and the Tribal Lifeline credits are also being changed as a result of the offset between the Federal Access Change and the WTAP and Tribal Lifeline credits.

These pages have been prepared with an effective date of October 18, 2014, and an effective bill date of October 1, 2014, in order to coincide with the effective date of the Access Charge increase in the federal tariff.
