Enclosed is Cascade's Summary of Meter Performance for year 2014 for all residential and small commercial meters in service as of December 31, 2014. These meters fall within the scope of the company's Statistical Sample Program dated August 18, 1995. Please note that the plan was revised November 3, 2014 to allow test results from multiple years be used in samples where a sufficiently sized sample from a family could not be achieved before the end of the year due to meters failing late in the plan year. Revisions to the plan are highlighted in yellow.

All larger meters in service were tested according to their required periodic schedule. The total number of meters in service in Washington at the end of 2014 was 210,656.
