


### DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

1. **Description of Proposal:** Transportation of General Commodities in the state of Washington, including one of the following types of hazardous materials:
  - a. Petroleum or petroleum products in bulk in tank-type vehicles.
  - b. Radioactive substances.
  - c. Explosives.
  - d. Corrosives.
  
2. **Proponent:** C.H. Wilson Transport Inc.

4. **Location of Proposal:** Transportation of materials on various roads, streets, or highways within the state of Washington.
  
5. **Lead Agency:** Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
  
6. **Determination:** The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) determined that granting the permit in this matter does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of the application submitted by the applicant together with the commission's program-wide SEPA review for common carrier hazardous materials permits.
