1 **STRIKING AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED MOTION 2016-0386, VERSION 1**

2 On page 1, beginning on line 5, strike everything through page 6, line 97, and insert:

3 "STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 4 1. The solid waste division of the department of natural resources and  
5 parks provides essential public services that protect human health, the  
6 environment, and the quality of life in our region.
- 7 2. The solid waste division operates the Cedar Hills regional landfill,  
8 eight transfer stations, and two drop boxes. It also provides innovative  
9 programs to help customers recycle and prevent waste.
- 10 3. The solid waste division is an enterprise fund, supporting almost all  
11 (ninety-five percent) of its services with a basic fee charged for each ton  
12 of municipal solid waste received at county facilities.
- 13 4. The solid waste basic fee for 2013-2014 took effect on January 1, 2013,  
14 with a further increase scheduled for the 2015-2016 rate period.
- 15 5. By achieving efficiencies and refocusing priorities, the division  
16 extended the 2013-2014 two-year rate for an additional two years, saving  
17 customers twenty-two million dollars in 2015 and 2016.

18 6. A fee increase can no longer be deferred if the solid waste division is to  
19 sustain current services, repay debt on previously approved transfer station  
20 projects, plan and provide system handling and disposal capacity into the  
21 future and expand recycling programs throughout the system.

22 7. The proposed new basic fee is less than the 2017 fee projected in the  
23 last rate proposal and in line with rates charged by comparable solid waste  
24 service providers in the region.

25 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

26 SECTION 1. A. This ordinance proposes changes to the fees currently charged  
27 for solid waste disposal at solid waste transfer stations and drop boxes and at the Cedar  
28 Hills regional landfill.

29 B. These fees are established and assessed pursuant to RCW 36.58.040, RCW  
30 70.93.070 and K.C.C. 10.08.040.

31 SECTION 2. Ordinance 12586, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.021 are  
32 each hereby amended as follows:

33 A. All persons using county-operated solid waste transfer stations and drop boxes  
34 shall pay the service fees in the following schedules:

35 1. Solid waste disposal:

36	Passenger cars	<del>\$((19.22))</del> <u>21.60</u> per entry
37	Other vehicles	<del>\$((120.17))</del> <u>134.59</u> per ton
38	Charitable organizations	<del>\$((92.55))</del> <u>103.63</u> per ton
39	Minimum	<del>\$((19.22))</del> <u>21.60</u> per vehicle
40	Charitable organizations, minimum charge	<del>\$((15.08))</del> <u>16.58</u> per entry

41           2. Deposit of source-separated yard waste at yard waste collection areas, clean  
42 wood at clean wood collection areas, or any combination thereof:

43           Passenger cars	\$12.00 per entry
44           Other vehicles	\$75.00 per ton
45           Minimum charge	\$12.00 per vehicle

46           3. Deposit of white goods at white goods collection areas:

47           White goods without regulated refrigerants	\$10.00 per unit
48           White goods with regulated refrigerants	\$30.00 per unit

49           B. Service fees for the use of solid waste facilities without scales shall be based  
50 upon the cubic yard or fraction thereof as follows:

51           1. Solid waste disposal:

52           Passenger cars	<del>\$((19.67))</del> <u>21.60</u> per entry
53           Other vehicles:	
54           Compacted wastes	<del>\$((35.34))</del> <u>39.03</u> per cubic yard
55           Uncompacted wastes	<del>\$((20.70))</del> <u>22.88</u> per cubic yard
56           Minimum charge	<del>\$((19.67))</del> <u>21.60</u> per vehicle

57           2. Deposit of source-separated yard waste at yard waste collection areas, clean  
58 wood at clean wood collection areas, or any combination thereof:

59           Passenger cars	\$12.00 per entry
60           Other vehicles:	
61           Compacted wastes	\$21.75 per cubic yard
62           Uncompacted wastes	\$12.75 per cubic yard
63           Minimum charge	\$12.00 per vehicle

64 C. Service fees at the Cedar Hills regional landfill shall be:

65	Cedar Hills Regional Direct	<del>\$((103.50))</del> <u>114.00</u> per ton
66	Other vehicles	<del>\$((121.75))</del> <u>134.59</u> per ton

67 Disposal by other vehicles is at the discretion of the division director.

68 D. A moderate-risk waste surcharge shall be added to all solid waste disposed by  
69 nonsolid waste collection entities using county operated solid waste facilities. The fee  
70 schedule is as follows:

71 1. For facilities with scales:

72	Self-haulers	\$4.73 per ton
73	Minimum charge	\$1.81 per entry
74	Passenger cars	\$1.81 per entry

75 2. For facilities without scales:

76	Compacted	\$1.04 per cubic yard
77	Uncompacted	\$0.59 per cubic yard
78	Minimum charge	\$1.81 per entry
79	Passenger cars	\$1.81 per entry

80 E. As determined by the division director, a special waste fee shall be charged for  
81 special waste including asbestos-containing waste material and other wastes requiring  
82 clearances in accordance with King County Board of Health Code Title 10 or rules  
83 adopted by the department.

84	Special waste fee	<del>\$((145.00))</del> <u>162.00</u> per ton
85	Special waste fee minimum charge	<del>\$((23.20))</del> <u>25.84</u> per entry
86	Special waste fee, extra handling	<del>\$((175.00))</del> <u>188.00</u> per ton
