Re: Review Committee Decision - Case Number 17-006

Dear Mr. King:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee received a complaint regarding a potential violation of the Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030(2)(5) for work performed on December 15, 2016.

On July 19, 2017, the Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee Review Board heard complaint Case 17-006 Puget Sound Energy vs Omni Contracting Solutions, LLC.

The Review Committee determined that the respondent, Omni Contracting Solutions, LLC. did violate RCW 19.122.030(2) by failing to request locates and RCW 19.122.030(5) for commencing excavation before all known facilities were placed or information was provided by utility operators.

The Review Committee recommends the following penalty be assessed to the respondent:

- \$1000.00 for violating 19.122.030(2)
- \$2000.00 for violating 19.122.030(5)

The Safety Committee recommends that \$2000.00 be deferred if all Omni Contracting Solutions owners, business leaders and field supervisors complete NUCA Dig Safe training within 90 days of receiving assessment.
