RE: Advice 17-08—Schedule 51—Street Lighting Service

Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company), a division of PacifiCorp, submits this proposed tariff applicable to Pacific Power's electric service in the state of Washington in compliance with RCW 80.28.050, WAC Chapter 480-80, and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Rules and Regulations. The Company respectfully request an effective date of November 30, 2017.

Seventh Revision to Sheet No. 51.1 Schedule 51 Street Lighting Service – Company-Owned System

The purpose of this filing is to add a new pricing option for Company-owned light-emitting diode (LED) street lights whose conversion from another lighting type is funded by a specific customer. Since the rates for LED street lights are generally lower than other types of equivalent street lighting, customer-requested conversion to LED does not typically provide incremental new revenue and therefore per the Company's Rule 14 the customer does not receive a line extension allowance and consequently funds the full cost of conversion. Additionally, the state of Washington's Transportation improvement Board offers a program (Relight Washington) for eligible cities to receive funding to convert to LED street lights. Responsive to customer interest in the program and conversion to LED street lighting, the Company is proposing this new pricing option. Proposed rates are calculated by considering all of the costs of providing Company-owned street light service for its six standard sizes, except for the cost of installing the luminaire.
