Gentlemen:

Pursuant to RCW 70.95.212 please accept this letter as 75 day notification of disposal rate adjustment.

New disposal rates becoming **effective January 1, 2018**, are as follows:

1. A 3.61% decrease for solid waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy facility. Disposal fee for solid waste at the Waste to Energy Facility is going from \$108.41 per ton to \$104.50 per ton. The minimum fee for solid waste is increasing from \$16.59 to \$17.07.
2. A 2.9% increase for clean green yard waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy Facility. Disposal of clean green is going from \$51.21 per ton to \$52.70 per ton. The minimum fee for clean green is increasing from \$5.45 to \$5.61.
3. A 2.9% increase for waste delivered to the Waste to Energy Facility which the director determines requires special handling. Disposal fee for special handling waste is going from \$182.54 per ton to \$187.83 per ton. The minimum fee for waste requiring special handling is increasing from \$22.12 to \$93.92.
4. A 2.9% increase for waste tires delivered to the Waste to Energy Facility. Disposal fee is going from \$132.36 per ton to \$136.20 per ton. The minimum fee for waste tires is decreasing from \$31.77 to \$20.40.
