Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 8, Columbia River Disposal, Inc. G-48.

With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a general rate increase to recover new capital assets, higher costs for wages, and overall higher general operating costs.

The increases are proposed as follows: Residential service \$67,400, 15.05%; commercial service \$64,800, 15.05%; and roll-off service \$22,200, 15.05%. There are approximately 1,630 residential; 240 commercial; and 16 roll-off customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by the Commission became effective October 1, 2016. Since that time, the Company has experienced increases in operating costs in the areas of labor, employee benefits, fuel, parts and equipment amongst other categories which it now seeks to update in rates.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages containing the increased rates, as well as supporting documentation for those changes. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they are intended to become effective on April 1, 2018.

A rate increase notification letter will be mailed to all customers affected by these proposed changes no later than February 28, 2018. A notice letter will also be delivered on or before February 28, 2018 to the office of the Skamania County Council Chair.
