RE: Docket UE-18 _____ —Affiliated Interest Filing—PacifiCorp and BNSF Railway Company

Under the provisions of RCW 80.16.020 and in accordance with WAC 480-100-245, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, provides notice of an affiliated interest transaction with BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) for a license allowing PacifiCorp to replace, relocate, and install certain electric facilities along or across BNSF property in Wapato, Washington. A verified copy of the License for Electric Supply Line Across or Along Railway Property (License), is included with this Notice as Attachment A.

PacifiCorp is a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway Energy Company (BHE). BHE is a subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway, Inc. BNSF is also a subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway, Inc. RCW 80.16.010 includes in its definition of “affiliated interest,” “every corporation five percent or more of whose voting securities are owned by any person or corporation owning five percent or more of the voting securities of such public service company or by any person or corporation in any such chain of successive ownership of five percent or more of voting securities.” Therefore, Berkshire Hathaway, Inc.’s ownership interest in BHE and BNSF creates an affiliated interest relationship between the company and BNSF.

PacifiCorp is reconfiguring existing permitted facilities on BSNF property to provide service to a City of Wapato pump. The reconfiguration includes the addition of a third phase to a 12.5kv line, replacement of two pole-mounted 10kVA 120/240V transformers with three 10KVA 277/480V transformers, relocation of overhead service lines to underground, replacement of an old meter, and the addition of necessary guys and anchors. These modifications require crossing BNSF’s property.

BNSF uses standardized pricing for these types of licenses. PacifiCorp will pay \$5,006 total, which includes \$3,700 for the License, \$800 for additional processing, and \$506 for Railroad protective liability insurance. Obtaining the License is in the public interest because it allows PacifiCorp to install and maintain facilities necessary to provide electric service and meet its obligation to provide safe and reliable electric service. Without the licenses, PacifiCorp would not be able to meet its obligation to provide electric service. As the property owner, BNSF is the only entity that can provide the License to PacifiCorp.

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Also included with this filing is a notarized verification from Scott Mease, Property Agent, regarding the License.
