These proposed tariffs are filed in legislative format in accordance with WAC 480-07-510(2).

# **Purpose of the Filing**

This is NW Natural's first general rate increase filing since the case filed in 2008 (Docket U-080546) with Tariff revisions effective January 1, 2009. This filing requests to increase revenues from base rates by \$8.3 million, which would result in an approximate 12.6 percent increase to overall base rates. The Company's request is based on a proposed rate of return of 7.63 percent, return on equity of 10.3 percent, and capital structure comprised of 49.5 percent

equity, 49.5 percent long-term debt, and 1 percent short-term debt. The full impact of the filing is described in greater detail in the Summary Document included with this filing. In addition, NW Natural proposes to implement a decoupling mechanism (Schedule 300), an environmental cost recovery mechanism (Schedule 303), and a mechanism that will adjust rates for the effects of the 2017 Federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) (Schedule 305).

In accordance with WAC 480-07-510(4)(a), electronic copies of supporting work papers will be filed with Commission Staff with a copy to Public Counsel within five business days of the date of this filing. The Company will provide reasonable access to the cost study model in accordance with WAC 480-07-510(6).

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## Effect on Customers

As proposed, this general rate case would increase the Company's sales service class customer rates as follows:

In accordance with WAC 480-07-160(5)(c), the Company has enclosed redacted versions of the documents containing confidential information along with the non-confidential documents in its filing, and has placed unredacted versions of the documents containing confidential information in separate envelopes with corresponding "SHADED INFORMATION IS DESIGNATED AS CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160" labels on the envelopes. Each page of the unredacted version containing confidential information has been printed on yellow paper.

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#### **Other Matters**

The Company waives its right to have this filing considered at an open meeting of the Commission as set forth in RCW 80.04.130(1) and consents to the Commission's prompt entry of an order suspending the filing and commencing an investigation.

The Company agrees that following suspension of this filing, it will provide notice pursuant to WAC 480-90-197. Accordingly, the notice provisions of WAC 480-90-194 are not required at this time for this filing.
