Dear Burton Water Customer,

Burton Water Company (BWC) has applied to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") for a surcharge of \$3.18 per month. The purpose of the surcharge is to reimburse the company for expenses incurred in well field protection efforts. As you may remember, there was a major road construction project last summer. The debris from the project was supposed to be taken off-island. Instead, it was deposited on island in the area of the wells that serve you. This posed a threat to your water safety. The company financed a substantial legal effort to get the debris removed and was successful in doing so. This effort protected your water. The surcharge reimburses the company for that effort. The surcharge also covers additional well field testing for the next five years.

If approved, this surcharge would take effect on July 1, 2019 and remain in effect until \$45,792.00 is collected plus state and federal taxes or June 30, 2022, whichever occurs first.

The commission has the authority to set final rates that may be lower or higher than the company's request, depending on the outcome of its investigation. You can submit comments by going to www.utc.wa.gov and clicking "Submit a Comment," or by one of the following options:
