UE-111048 and UG-111049 (Consolidated) as amended by Order 10 in Dockets UE-111048 and UG-111049 (consolidated); and to pass through to Customers the net proceeds related to the biogas acquired by PSE in accordance with the Commission's Order in Docket No. UE-131276.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

a. Eligibility: All Customers receiving bundled retail service.

4. FUNDING:

- a. Funding: Rate credits of \$1,630,871 (based on estimated loads) for pass through between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020.
- 5. **ADJUSTMENT:** In addition to the rate specified in the otherwise applicable rate schedules the following rate credits or charge will apply from the effective date of this tariff sheet until terminated.
- 6. **MONTHLY RATE:** The charges or credits shown in this schedule apply to the rate schedules identified on the following sheets and at the charge or credit shown for the applicable rate schedule.
