Re: Review Committee Decision - Case 20-014 POW Contracting vs. City of Moses Lake

Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee received a complaint regarding a potential violation of Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030 for work performed on August 23, 2019.

On May 20, 2020, the committee formed a review board and heard Case 20-014 filed by POW Contracting against the City of Moses Lake.

The review board determined that the respondent, the City of Moses Lake, violated RCW 19.122.040(1) for failing to acknowledge a change of conditions.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$1000.00 be assessed to the respondent as follows;

•\$1000.00 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122.040(1)

The recommended penalty is \$1000.00, with \$1000.00 deferred on the condition that the City of Moses Lake has no additional violations of RCW 19.122 within twelve months of receiving a penalty assessment order.
