





The victim was jogging northbound on main track 2 when he was struck by a northbound BNSF Railway freight train. The accident occurred in an area with limited access and the victim was transported by boat to a location with better access for rescue vehicles, he was then transported to Madigan Army Medical Center where he later died.

Man dies at hospital after being hit by train in Steilacoom Tuesday BY CRAIG SAILOR

JULY 15, 2020 11:52 AM , UPDATED 5 HOURS 19 MINUTES AGO

A pedestrian who was hit by a freight train Tuesday afternoon in Steilacoom died from his injuries.

The 23-year-old victim was hit by a BNSF train around 4 p.m. in the vicinity of Chapman Loop. He was taken to Madigan Army Medical Center.

Despite lifesaving efforts at the hospital, he was declared dead at 5:30 p.m., according to Madigan spokesman Woody Stone.



There were no on ground witnesses to the accident, according to Jenny Weekes, spokeswoman for West Pierce Fire & Rescue. Steep terrain prevented rescue crews from reaching the site via land, Weekes said.

West Pierce's fire boat crew rescued the victim and transferred him to shore at Saltar's Point.

A medical helicopter began flying the victim to Harborview Medical Center but his condition deteriorated and he was taken instead to Madigan.

The northbound freight train stopped at the scene. A southbound Amtrak Cascades passenger train was also stopped while the scene was investigated.

Investigative Information

General Report Narrative

On 7/14/20 I was working normal patrol duties in the town of Steilacoom. Officer Feleppa, Detective Bailey and I were dispatched to a train vs pedestrian collision between Chapman Loop Rd and West Shore Ct. I arrived in the area and started to look for a path to the railroad tracks. I was unable to locate a path down to the tracks from the location so I went to Saltars Point Beach to move south along the railroad tracks. Approximately 1,600 feet from the overpass at the beach (LAT/LONG 47.1646 -122.6144) I located West Pierce Fire and Rescue (WPFR) out with a male patient lying prone along the east side of the tracks in a pool of water. The patient was conscious, breathing, and speaking. The patient was identified as Remy Velarde and he kept stating he was struggling to breath and in a lot of pain. WPFR medics rendered medical aid and Detective Bailey coordinated with WPFR fire boat for a site to beach. Once the boat arrived I assisted officers and fire personnel with moving Remy under the stopped freight train, down a rock embankment and onto the fire boat.

WPFR created a landing zone for a helicopter evacuation to Harborview at Saltars Point Elementary, but eventually elected to transport via ambulance to Madigan hospital due to his deteriorating condition. I remained at the impact site and took photographs of his personal affects along the train. Officer Feleppa located a cell phone and pair of sunglasses. I spoke with the Engineer (Ross) and Conductor (Brown) who both stated it appeared Remy was out for a jog on the tracks. Ross and Brown both stated Remy was trespassing, running north on the northbound tracks as their freight train was also traveling north. They both stated the horn was blasted several times before placing the train into 'emergency' stop. Ross stated the train was traveling approximately 45 MPH just prior to striking the pedestrian. I obtained handwritten statements from both Ross and Brown.

I spoke with BNSF Police Officer Stapleton who provided me their case # 2052002452 and stated he would be following up at the hospital. The locomotive was #5154, the train ID #U-LAURBO0-11T and Remy was located approximately 15 cars back from the locomotive.

I cleared the scene while Detective Bailey and Officer Feleppa went to Madigan Hospital.

On 07/14/2020 at approximately 1546 hours, Officer Feleppa, Officer Hamrick, West Pierce Fire and Rescue (WPFR) and I were dispatched to the area of Chapman Loop at West Shore Court for a report of a train versus pedestrian in the Town of Steilacoom, County of Pierce. The reporting party was the engineer of the locomotive, and stated he was still trying to get his train stopped after the collision. There was another reporting party from within the area who stated they could hear the victim yelling for help, but did not know his exact location.

After arriving at this address, I attempted to access the train tracks from the above location, however there was a steep cliff approximately forty feet tall denying access to the victim. After attempting several routes and realizing none were safe, I accessed my vehicle and drove priority to 99 Champion St. to access the train tracks from Saltar's Beach. The front of the locomotive was located at the burned down marina, and I met with the engineer. He stated he walked the length of his train, but was unable to locate the victim. I began searching for the victim on foot, and located him on the south side of the train at approximately half the length of the train. He was lying face up within a shallow pool of water, in what is best described as a drainage ditch that runs parallel to the train tracks. The male was conscious and alert and speaking in full sentences. The male did not have any obvious signs of trauma, however it was evident he had unknown injuries as he was not able to move and was in a great deal of pain. WPFR arrived shortly after, and assisted me in caring for the patient. With WPFR caring for the patient medically, I diverted my attention to extrication and began coordinating efforts with the WPFR Captain to have their boat come to our location on the shore. Shortly after, the fire boat arrived, and WPFR, DuPont Police, and Steilacoom Police personnel and I carried the male underneath the train, down the rock embankment, and onto the WPFR boat. The boat transported the male to 1 Union Ave to an awaiting ambulance. I ran from the location back to my vehicle parked at 99 Champion, and drove priority to Saltar's Point Elementary located at 908 3rd St., where WPFR had coordinated a landing zone for an Airlift Northwest helicopter (TN#N953AL). Lakewood Police Officer Czuleger arrived to assist. Shortly after, the patient arrived by WPFR ambulance, as well the helicopter. The patient was loaded onto the helicopter, and personnel cleared the area for the helicopter to take flight. I observed the pilot increase rotor speed as though he was going to take flight, however he shut down and I could hear the helicopters engine return to idle. The pilot signaled to us to return to the helicopter, and we quickly learned the patient had "coded" and the flight nurses on board were performing cardio pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on the patient. WPFR personnel assisted in CPR, while I assisted in preparing the patient for ground transport. Shortly after, the patient was loaded into the ambulance, and the ambulance transported the male priority to Madigan Army Medical Center (MAMC). I followed the ambulance with lights and sirens activated.

Upon arrival to MAMC, lifesaving efforts continued, however at approximately 1744 hours, Dr. Sohn declared the patient deceased.

I made contact with Officer Feleppa via phone, who had spoken with next of kin and family friends from the area. They identified the victim as Velarde, Remy A. (06/26/1997), and Officer Feleppa stated they were enroute to MAMC. I awaited their arrival, where they were notified of Velarde's status and was consoled by MAMC chaplains and medical staff.

I then contacted Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Police who stated they did not intent to respond to the incident at that time. I passed on my contact information in the event they needed any information or assistance.
