Via notice dated September 8, 2020, Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. d/b/a Legacy Inmate Communications ("Legacy") and Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a NCIC Inmate Communications ("NCIC") notified the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission ("Commission") of a pending transaction pursuant to which Legacy would transfer its Washington customer base to NCIC (the "Transaction").
