

Tatoosh Water Company

IMPORTANT NOTICE

March 2, 2021

Tatoosh Water Company has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to approve an application to increase rates. If approved, the new rates will become effective May 1, 2021. If approved, this increase would generate approximately an additional \$3,600 in monthly revenue to cover expenses.

The water rate increase will help cover increased expenses such as contract operations, repairs, maintenance, and insurance. The current rates were set in 2017 and do not cover current expenses. Expense deficits have been paid for by the owners of Tatoosh Water Company.

Usage rates are per 100 cf. One cubic foot=approx.7.48 gallons.
