Dear Mr. Johnson:

We respectfully request to update the rates under G-48 to reflect the increase in disposal fee from \$78.69 to \$80.15 per ton, a 1.86% increase. This increase reflects the current practice of disposing all solid waste collected within Skamania County at the Skamania County Transfer Station. This will increase revenue from residential customers by approximately \$1,900 (0.43%); commercial customers by \$2,100 (0.46%); and drop box customers by \$3,200 (2.05%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 2,000 residential, 300 commercial, and 19 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase for G-48 became effective April 1, 2018.

Although Columbia River Disposal, Inc. includes G-48 and G-51 and share financial statements, this change only affects G-48.

Attached are revised pages as well as supporting documentation to justify this increase. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective July 1, 2021. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2) (iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
