Spokane County is pleased to provide this letter as determination of the revenue sharing plan (Plan) managed by Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (WM) complying with RCW 81.77.185. The Plan referenced herein applies to the areas in WM's G-237 certificated territory within Spokane County. The purpose of this letter is to report the County's findings regarding the execution of WM's Plan beginning August 1, 2020 and ending July 31, 2022.

August 1, 2020 – June 1, 2021

To date, Spokane County is satisfied with WM's efforts to implement the education and outreach tasks outlined in the Plan. WM has provided detailed summaries of activities and associated costs to Spokane County, and to the best of our knowledge, the expenditures reported by WM are justifiable and appropriate. Tasks were implemented according to the Plan with a few mutually agreed upon adjustments due to fluctuations in commodity prices. We expect further adjustments in the second year of the agreement but are confident that the education and outreach activities outlined in the Plan can be sustained. We look forward to continued implementation of the Plan with WM.
