Customer will be charged for service requested, even if fewer containers are serviced on a particular trip. No credit will be given for partially-filled containers.
- Note 2: Permanent Service: If rent is shown, the rate for the first pickup and each additional pickup must be the same. If rent is not shown, it is to be included in the rate for the first pickup.
- Note 3: 1, 2, & 3 yard containers must be pushed to truck for loading. See Item 207 for weight limit and Item 205 for roll-out charges
- Note 4: 4, 6, & 8 yard containers are served by front load trucks in place.
- Accessorial charges assessed (lids, tarping, unlocking, unlatching, etc.)
- Note 5: A gate or obstruction charge of \$2.17(N) per pick up will be assessed for opening, unlocking or closing gates or moving obstructions in order to pick up solid waste.
- Note 6: A lock fee of \$2.17(N) per pick up will be assessed for unlocking padlocks or other locking devices on container to perform pick up service
- Occasional extra units shall be charged \$4.49 Each
