Dear City and Tribal Partners:

I am writing to remind you about the annual rate change in Hazardous Waste Management Program fees beginning January 1, 2022.

In 2018, the King County Board of Health set the Hazardous Waste fees for 2019 through 2022, which include annual adjustments. The rate schedule is shown in the table below:

## Hazardous Waste Rates 2019-2022
