

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Attached you will find the above referenced tariff sheets. The language on Sheet 19.1 was inadvertently omitted when the new tariff was prepared and filed. This language reflects how customers in multiple unit dwellings have been treated in the past and continues their treatment on a forward going basis with no change in what they pay for service. There are customers that would be affected if this language is not reinstated. The changes to Sheets 13 and 14 are to remove an inconsistency pointed out by Commission Staff.

Because this tariff filing maintains the way service has been provided in the past, this is a change to the tariff that does not affect the public and pursuant to WAC 480-80-123(2)(d) does not require statutory notice. Therefore, it is being filed on two days notice.
