PROPOSED RATE INCREASE NOTICE

Dear Valued Customer:

Trilogy MedWaste West (“Trilogy”) is pleased to be your biomedical provider and we greatly appreciate your continued business.

In this post pandemic, supply chain-impacted operating environment, the biomedical waste industry is facing particular challenges. Rapidly accelerating costs for processing biomedical waste, labor, fuel, equipment, transportation and maintenance expenses have all escalated dramatically, increasing costs for us to continue to provide collection, transportation, and/or disposal services for you. All of the above mentioned costs continue to rise particularly over recent times since our predecessor’s last rate adjustment effective July 1, 2019.

Due to the above cost pressures, we have submitted proposed revised rates subject to the review and approval of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“UTC”). If approved, the new rates would become effective July 1, 2022. While we regret having to adjust rates, in order to maintain appropriate service levels we must seek to recoup some of the attrition in our cost base we have experienced over the past three years.

The UTC will review our filing and has the authority to set final rates that may vary from our requests, either higher or lower or structured differently, depending on the results of its review.
