
RE: Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Application of Ziplly Wireless, LLC

Dear Commission:

Ziplly Wireless, LLC ("Ziplly") is petitioning the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to be a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC"). In a previous docket for Ziplly's affiliate – Ziplly Fiber Pacific - Commission staff requested Ziplly's parent company, Northwest Fiber, LLC ("NWF"), to file a statement regarding Ziplly and its financial responsibilities in lieu of filing a balance sheet. Ziplly and NWF are sending this letter for the same purpose.

Ziplly is a wholly-owned subsidiary of NWF. NWF serves as the Member-Manager of Ziplly. In connection with Ziplly serving as a CLEC, NWF will guarantee Ziplly's obligations for the time that NWF controls Ziplly. Any future change in control of Ziplly would be subject to further Commission notice.
