The company requests Commission approval to amend its filed Tariff Number 19 on Less Than Statutory Notice to increase its Special Fuel Surcharge Tariff Supplement to recover the rising cost of fuel. Fuel index prices have increased from \$3.1611 per gallon for the base period to \$5.4065 per gallon current price. The proposed change is to implement a 1.97% surcharge in Supplement 3. Supplement 2 expired November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: January 1, 2023.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: March 31, 2023.
3. The temporary 1.97% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of October 2022, and November 2022, to be collected from customers as follows:

Customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears: The fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of January 2023 and February 2023.

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services – current month and one month in advance:

Customers Billed in Month end:	Fuel Surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of:
January 31, 2023	January 2023, and February 2023
February 28, 2023	February 2023, and March 2023

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services – two months in advance:

Customers Billed:	Fuel Surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of:
January 1, 2023	January 2023, and February 2023
February 1, 2023	February 2023, and March 2023
