PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) submits this proposed tariff applicable to PacifiCorp's electric service in the state of Washington in compliance with RCW 80.28.050, WAC Chapter 480-80 et. seq., and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Rules and Regulations. PacifiCorp respectfully requests an effective date of July 14, 2023.

Second Revision of Sheet No. 114.4    Schedule 114    Residential Energy Efficiency Rider—  
Optional for Qualifying Low Income  
Customers

The purpose of this filing is to propose changes to Schedule 114 to add smart thermostats. The smart thermostat measure does not replace the current programmable thermostat measure but is an additional option that contractors can install. The smart thermostat must be installed with an electric heating system – either an electric resistance furnace or an air-source heat pump – and must be Energy Star qualified.

PacifiCorp proposes to add smart thermostats because they can often save more energy than timed thermostats by adjusting the temperature when the occupant is not home. Some customers find that mobile app programming is easier than the controls on the timed thermostat device. In addition, smart thermostats will enable homeowners to participate in potential, future demand response programs for additional savings and incentives.
