## Re: Docket UE-24\_\_\_\_\_\_—Affiliated Interest Filing—PacifiCorp and Nevada Power Company

Under the provisions of RCW 80.16.020 and in accordance with WAC 480-100-245, PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp), provides notice of an affiliated interest transaction with the Nevada Power Company, d/b/a NV Energy, (NV Energy) to enter into an agreement (the Agreement) through which PacifiCorp will supply NV Energy with pole transformers. The pole transformers are needed by NV Energy for a critical project. The sale will be effected through a bill of sale. A verified copy of the bill of sale is included with this notice as Attachment A.

PacifiCorp is a wholly owned, indirect subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway Energy Company (BHE). NV Energy is also a wholly owned, indirect subsidiary of BHE. RCW 80.16.020 includes in its definition of "affiliated interest," "every corporation five percent or more of whose voting securities are owned by any person or corporation owning five percent or more of the voting securities of such public service company or by any person or corporation in any such chain of successive ownership of five percent or more of voting securities." Therefore, BHE's ownership interest in both companies creates an affiliated interest between PacifiCorp and NV Energy.

The value of the equipment to be purchased by NV Energy under the Agreement is approximately \$44,991.30. NV Energy will pay PacifiCorp the cost of the parts, including administrative expenses, which is higher than the market price. Thus, PacifiCorp's sale of this equipment under the Agreement is in the public interest.

Also included with this filing is a signed verification regarding the Agreements from Peggi Herdt, Investment Recovery Specialist.
