DECLARATION OF JACK PEASLEY IN

1 I, Jack Peasley, under penalty of perjury of the laws of the State of Washington say as follows:


2 I am over the age of 18, a citizen of the United States, resident of the State of Washington and
competent to act as a witness in this matter.

3 As current Mayor of the City of Pomeroy, Washington, I submit this Declaration to verify that
the City now wishes to opt back into the regulation of solid waste collection within its
municipal borders by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission as authorized
under RCW 81.77.0201 by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.

4 This decision is formalized and verified by the accompanying of the Municipal Ordinance
reflecting the action of the City incorporated by this reference.

5 To the best of my knowledge and belief, Carroll-Naslund, Inc. received no compensation for
the cancelation of the portion of the solid waste certificate covering Pomeroy when it entered
into a contract for solid waste collection with Pomeroy decades ago.
