*** Present provisions are:**
Commodity debit adjustment of \$3.54 per residential recycling customer and \$1.98 per multi-family recycling customer.

*** Proposed changes are:**
Commodity debit adjustment decrease of \$1.24 to \$2.30 per residential recycling customer and decrease of \$1.94 to \$0.04 per multi-family recycling customer.

*** Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision:**
The commodity adjustment currently in effect in tariff 18 expires on September 30, 2024, this proposal will enact a new commodity adjustment effective for one year beginning October 1, 2024.

*** Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste):**
While the proposed rate change was filed within the statutory required 45 days, customers will be notified of this change on their first bill after the change becomes effective.
