Dear Mr. Killip:

Enclosed are the revised pages 2, 22, 23 and 24 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of these tariff revisions is to reflect the change in the commodity adjustment for residential customers receiving subscription recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect a change in the current recycling adjustment from a credit of \$1.69 per month to a credit of \$1.97 per month for residential customers. We are requesting that these tariff revisions go into effect on July 1, 2025.

This adjustment is jointly due to the change in commodity values, tonnages and materials composition since the commodity adjustment on July 1, 2024. Furthermore, consistent with most other commodity rebate filings recently approved, with this filing we are estimating the projected revenues be based on the revenues received over the most recent 12 months.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. Customers will be notified of the revised commodity adjustment as a message on their first invoice after the tariff is approved. The affected counties and municipalities have been notified of these proposed tariff changes.
