Enclosed are proposed revisions to Tariff #5.1 for Ada-Lin Waste Systems, Inc. (G-104). The purpose of this filing is to increase rates due to the disposal increase in Spokane County and the Washington B&O tax increase that took place on October 1, 2025.

If approved, these proposed rates will generate approximately \$3,200 annually or about 1.6% on tariff revenue.

We request LSN handling with respect to customer notification with rates going into effect 1-1-2026 and customers to be notified on their next regular billing in accordance with WAC 480-70-271(2)(a).
