- 1. The Miller and Sobek crossings be entered appropriately on the Commission's rolls of public crossings within the State.
- 2. The County's petitions for construction of public crossings at the Miller and Sobek grade crossings in Docket Nos. TR-940852 and TR-940851 are dismissed because the crossings already exist and because they predate the law requiring approval for crossings of railroads by county roads.
- 3. Mr. Miller's complaint against the Burlington Northern Railroad in Docket No. TR-940287, is denied.
