The Department of Ecology (Ecology) received Yakima County's Preliminary Draft Comprehensive Solid Waste and Moderate Risk Waste Management Plan (Plan) and a formal request for review of the Plan on November 3, 2022. The UTC shall then review the Plan's assessment of solid waste collection cost impacts on rates charged by solid waste collection companies regulated under chapter 81.77 RCW and advise the submitting entity and Ecology of the probable effect of the plan's recommendations on those rates.
