Dear Executive Secretary:

Attached is Tariff No. 18 to be effective March 1, 2024, which cancels Tariff No. 17, for Bainbridge Disposal, Inc. ("BDI").

The tariff includes rates for Bainbridge Island, Kitsap County.

Bainbridge Disposal Inc.'s last general rate increase was effective February 1, 2017. Over the last seven years many cost increases have occurred including payroll and related costs, insurance and equipment costs. It is, therefore, necessary to increase rates to our customers to cover our ever-increasing cost of providing service.

The Lurito-Gallagher formula provides an available increase in revenues of approximately \$1,500,000. The enclosed price out analysis shows revenue generation projected for the rates requested to be \$959,000. This represents an overall increase in revenues, without pass-through revenues, of 21%. Increases to rates charged to customers are approximately 27%.

As required by Commission rules, a copy of this transmittal letter will be mailed to the County Councils and to the Mayors of all cities impacted by this filing. We will be mailing notices to all affected customers on or before January 15, 2024. We have included a copy of our proposed customer notices with this filing.

Bainbridge Disposal keeps its records on the cash basis of accounting and files its income tax returns based on this method as well. It would be an undue hardship to convert these cash basis records to accrual. We did not observe significant payments near the end of or immediately after the reporting period. Please accept these filings on the cash basis of accounting as the Company has historically used for its filings.
