Discussion at Friday's Meeting

This spreadsheet reflects the relative percentages of the study area average support per line on a) a sub-wire-center basis (as USAC has implemented for the last two years), and b) an exchange level basis (which staff is amenable toward if companies find it more desirable).

The spreadsheet I sent earlier today portrays an example of what the dollars per line per month would look like for each respective area given the relative percentages presented here. The exchange level relative percentages are based on a reaggregation of the sub-wire-center level support amounts filed in support of the 1998 petition to the FCC (which USAC implemented).
